
Existing Airfield Overview



Airport Infrastructure Resiliency

Identification of Climate-Related Threats

• Sea-level rise / extreme temperatures / rainfall patterns / extreme storm events



Asset Evaluation

- Airfield pavements
- Electrical systems
- Airport structures
- Support facilities
- Utilities

Alternatives Analysis

Evaluate for:

- Technical feasibility meets FAA standards
- Operational feasibility flexibility, meets forecast users' needs
- Conformance with local, state and regional planning
- Financial feasibility avoid excessive costs
- Social and political feasibility community acceptance
- Environmental impacts minimize
- Highest and best use

Potential Airside Development

Areas

Identifies areas for additional hangar development to meet current and future demand




Funding Sources

- Federal
 - Airport Improvement Program
 - Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (5 years, starting in FY 2022)
 - Requires acceptance of grant assurances
- FDOT Aviation Grant Program
 - Match on FAA grants
 - State-local grant programs
- Airport-generated revenue

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


